FEBRUARY BRAMPTON

- In the event of severe weather conditions, the Director of Services, Member Services Worker or CEO in consultation with the Leaders of the Activity, has the authority, usually 4 hours before the scheduled start of the activity, to cancel the activity. A message with respect to the cancellation will be placed on the office answering service announcement.
- Members are eligible for Transit Subsidy if attending two social activities each month, Training Programs, Governance Meetings, Special Events (as designated) or as Leaders of an Activity.
- In order to be counted in attendance, at an activity, you must be present from the beginning of the scheduled time for the activity and you must stay until the end of the activity to be counted.
- Leaders will be available to the activity ½ hour before the scheduled start of the Activity.
